		Make sure your Business is Registered with the Missouri Secretary of State.
		Check to see if your location is in a TDD.
		If you are retail (sell product) or a restaurant, you will need a current Certificate of No Tax Due from Missouri Department of Revenue showing Harrisonville.
		Pawn shops, small loan establishments; private security and private investigators have a different application, fee, and require Bond.
		Those selling farm produce in business parking lots must have written permission from the business owner, charge and collect sales tax, and may be charged a fee of \$100.00.
		If you sell Liquor or Cigarettes, an additional license fee will be required.
		General Contractors and MEP Contractors will need a current Certificate of Insurance with Work Comp and liability on it. 816-380-8958
		MEP Contractors will also need proof of Master Trade.
		Tree trimmers, massage therapists and massage establishments have a different Application and require Bond.
