HAPPY FOURTH OF JULY HARRISONVILLE HOMETOWN CELEBRATION

The Harrisonville Parks and Recreation Department will host their Harrisonville Hometown Celebration on Thursday, July 4, at City Park!

Food trucks will be there, for those looking for a bite to eat.

The park will be open during normal hours but parking is limited within City Park.

These areas will be marked. There will also be parking in other areas around the City Park, which will be marked. The outdoor pool will be open for standard hours on the 4th. It will not be open during the fireworks display.

The fireworks will start at dusk, at approximately 9:30 p.m., and will be displayed from Camp Reeder. Established park rules will apply. If the event is rained out, the rain out date will be July 5. Please keep an eye on City social media pages for more-detailed information about parking for the event.

Zoning Commission meets on the third Thursday of each month. The Historic Preservation Commission meets on the first Wednesday of each month.

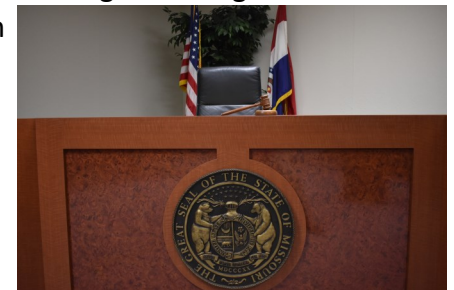
All meetings are open to the public.

Fireworks Guidelines — Most people would agree that fireworks are one of the best things about the Fourth of July. In Harrisonville, fireworks may be purchased from a licensed vendor from June 20, through July 5. All vendors are required to have a City-issued business license. Most fireworks may be



enjoyed within the city limits on July 1-2, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 10 p.m., as well as from 9 a.m. until midnight on July 3-4.

As a reminder, **lit fireworks may not be thrown from a moving vehicle nor can bottle rockets be shot in the city. Remember, all fireworks exhibitions require both a permit and the payment of a fee.**

Sign Up for Autopay! — Looking for an easier way to pay your utility bill?

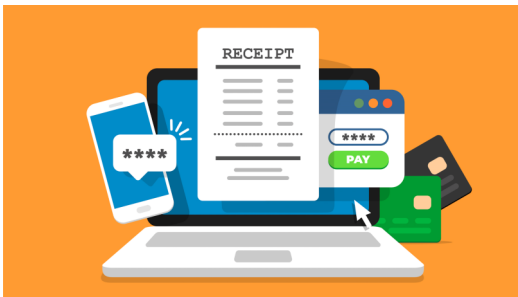
Autopay could be your answer! Autopay saves time, money, and worry when paying your utility bill. With Autopay, your bill is paid automatically from your checking account on the 15th of each month, with no processing fees or additional deductions.

Autopay users still receive a monthly statement from the City that will tell you the

amount of your utility bill. But you do nothing. The bill will be paid automatically from your account, as long as there are enough funds available for withdrawal.

To sign up for Autopay, speak with our Utility staff at City Hall or download an authorization form at www.harrisonville.com/135/autopay

As a reminder, utility bills are due on the first day of each month and must be paid by 5 p.m. on the 15th of the month to avoid a 10-percent penalty.
