**Trio of clean-up events planned** — Three clean up events are in the works for Harrisonville residents in the month of October.

**City-Wide Clean Up** — The first event is the fall edition of the bi-annual City-Wide Clean-Up, which will be held on October 12, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Bring items to 2606 Rock Haven Road and drop them off for FREE!

Accepted items at no cost include: non-Freon appliances and metal items, water heaters, furniture, light construction debris, limited to one 16-foot trailer, and household trash. Freon appliances are accepted, for a \$25 charge. Items not accepted include: tires, auto batteries, oil, hazardous chemicals, paint, roofing shingles and yard waste. The event is limited to those living within the City limits.

**E-Waste Collection** — The second event will be the Cass County E-Waste Collection on October 19. The event will be held at The Family Center inside Mill-Walk Mall and will run from 8 a.m. until noon. Many items are accepted for free; others are accepted for a small fee. A fee will apply to all CRT Monitors and CRT Televisions. Items accepted at no charge include: computers, keyboards, printers, laptops, tablets, cell phones, telephones, cassette players, DVD/CD players and VCRs. Applicable fees must be paid for by cash or check. Items not accepted include: CDs, floppy disks, flash drives or VCR tapes. This event is provided through a partnership of the Cass County Sustainability Committee, The Family Center and Meredith Recycling, Montrose, Missouri.

**City-Wide Brush Drop Off** — The third event will be the bi-annual brush drop off on October 25-26. The drop off location will be open from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. on both days, with gates closing promptly at 5 p.m. To access the drop off site, residents should follow the directional

No yard waste will be accepted. The event is limited to those living within the City limits. Contractors will not be permitted to use the service. Mulch and compost will be available for residents. Equipment for loading outgoing materials will be provided.

**For events limited to Harrisonville residents, residents should be prepared to show proof of residency, such as a utility bill, before using the drop off.**
